Tennessee State University's **Main Campus** is located five minutes west of downtown Nashville at:

3500 John A. Merritt Blvd.,
Nashville, TN 37209.



Directions to Main Campus

From the north, via I-65, or the northwest, via I-24:

Approaching Nashville, I-24 merges with I-65. Continue south on I-65 to I-40 and proceed west. Take the 28th Ave. exit. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp, then go to the first traffic light and turn left onto John A. Merritt Boulevard. Continue to the next stop sign—the Campus Center (Floyd-Payne Building) is on the left.

From the south, via I-65, or from the southeast, via I-24:

Take either route to I-40 and proceed west. Take the 28th Ave. exit. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp, then go to the first traffic light and turn left onto John A. Merritt Boulevard. Continue to the next stop sign—the Campus Center (Floyd-Payne Building) is on the left.

From the east, via I-40W:

Take exit 207. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Continue to the first traffic light and turn left onto John A. Merritt Boulevard. Continue to the next stop sign—the Campus Center (Floyd-Payne Building) is on the left.

From the west, via I-40E:

Take exit 207. Turn left at the end of the exit ramp and continue to the traffic light, then to the stop sign—the Campus Center (Floyd-Payne Building) is on the left.
