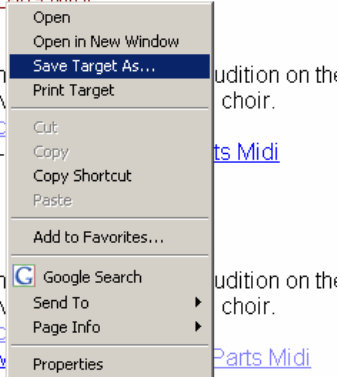

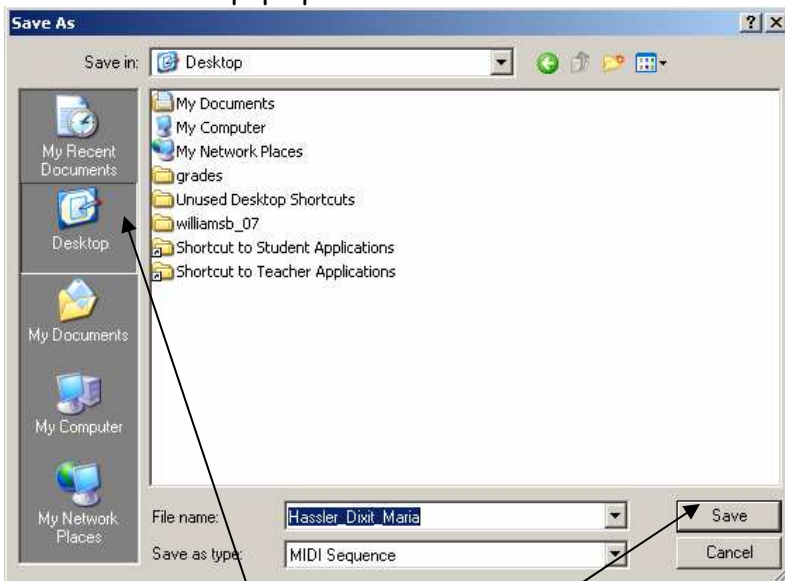

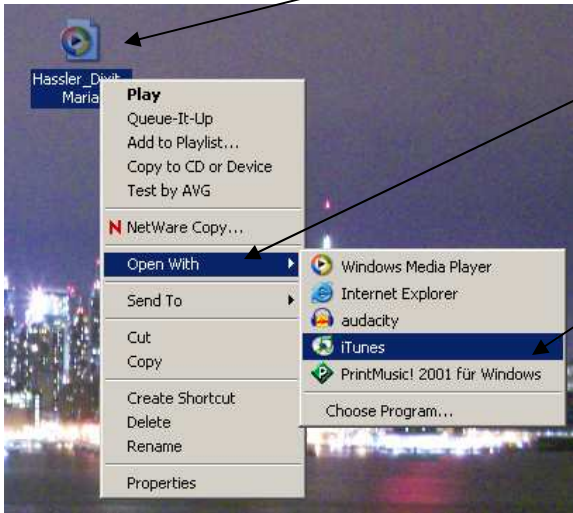


This window will pop up.



3. Select Desktop. And select save (the file name is already there). The file is now on your desktop.

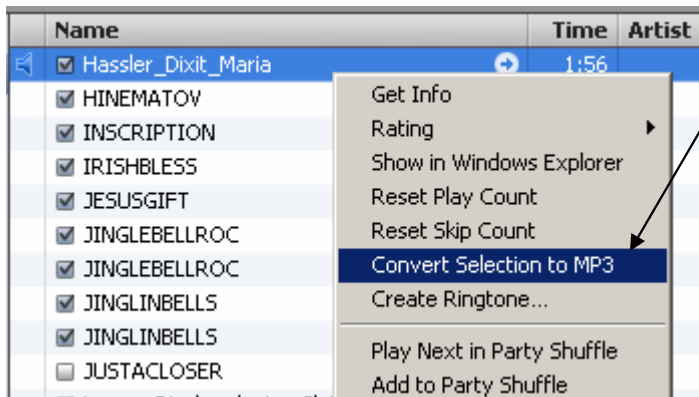
4. On your desktop, RIGHT-click on the file, and select OPEN WITH...iTUNES

5. RIGHT-click on your selection and choose CONVERT TO MP3



You'll see it "converting" on the left side of your screen:

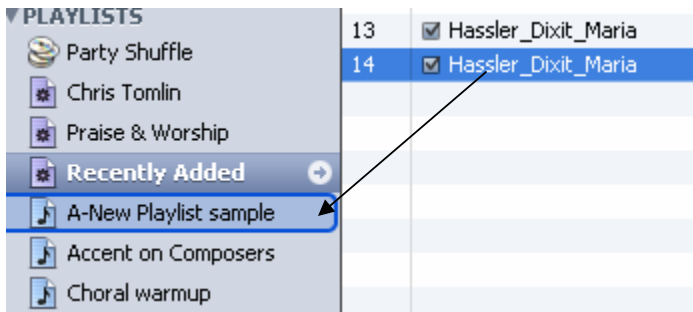


Now you see two of your song in iTunes - the second one is the one your just converted.

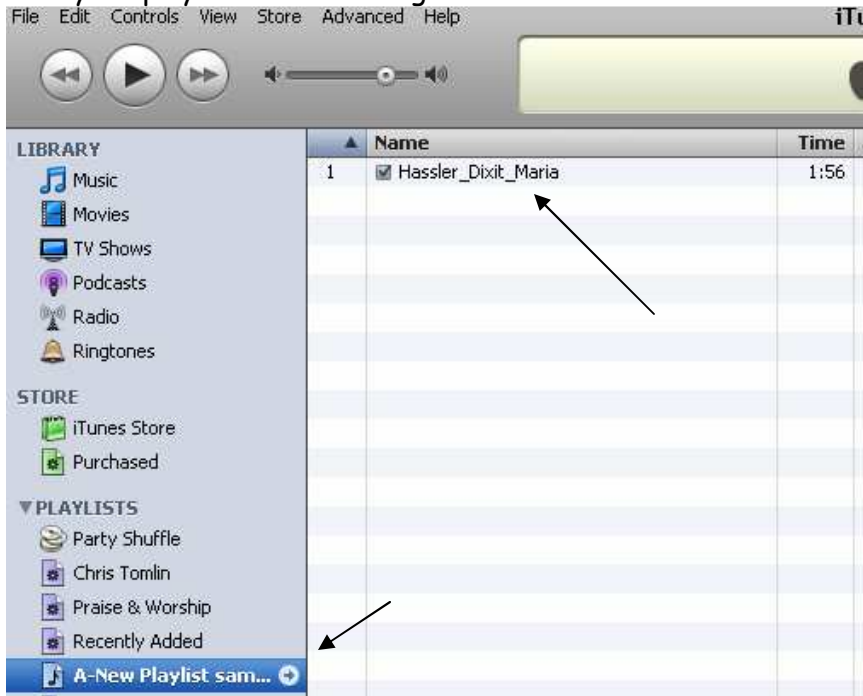
6. Now choose File - New Playlist (or Ctrl+N):
